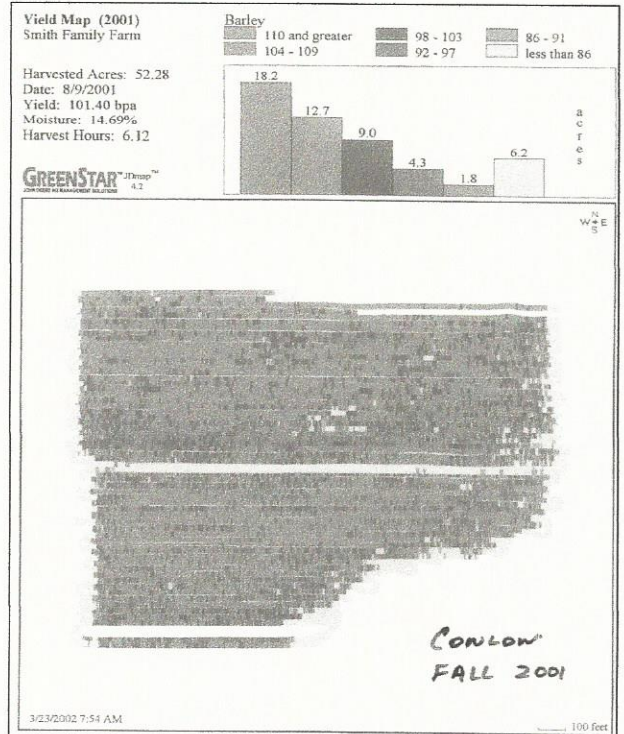

**AAC GATEWAY winter wheat:** A cross between CDC Osprey/N95L1226 made at the Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada Lethbridge Research Centre
